International Service

The RAWCS (Rotary Australia World Community Service) Rotahomes project is an ongoing project to build low cost housing to alleviate subhuman living conditions for impoverished families in Fiji. Volunteers working with the community residents have built 705 homes in country areas and 111 homes at Koripita community in Lautoka.

The project has two distinct focuses, providing cyclone proof homes and providing a comprehensive community development program. This is the third time that Tamar Sunrise has had volunteers assist in this project. Current members Peta Dolan and Lou Mason have been volunteers for K1 (the first town) where 85 homes were built. This year, we will have three members (Caro Brown, Peta Dolan and Melissa Carlton) working on K2 which will involve the construction of simple timber framed and steel clad homes each with a kitchen/shower and toilet block.

We also hope to provide support for the community program in Koripita while we are there. More on this at our meeting next week.
